संसार में असंख्य साधक ध्यान के माध्यम से परमात्मा को खोजते हैं। साधना आवश्यक है, पर यदि खोज केवल बाहरी रूपों तक सीमित रहे तो लक्ष्य तक पहुंचना कठिन हो जाता है। परम सत्य कहीं दूर नहीं, वह हमारे अंतःकरण में प्रतिष्ठित है। जबकि मनुष्य भौतिक भोगों में ही सुख खोजता है। निश्चय ही उनमें क्षणिक आनंद का आभास मिलता है, पर स्थायी सुख वहां संभव नहीं। वास्तविक सुख का उद्गम संयम, संतुलन और त्याग में है। संयम जीवन को अनुशासित करता है और मन को शांति प्रदान करता है। विडंबना यही है कि मनुष्य इस सत्य को जानते हुए भी उसे व्यवहार में नहीं उतारता। वह संयम की प्रशंसा तो करता है, पर जीवन में असंयम को ही स्थान देता है। परिणामस्वरूप वह असंतोष और दुख के चक्र में उलझा रहता है। आज दुनिया में बाहरी उपलब्धियों की चमक बढ़ी है, परंतु भीतर की शांति घटती जा रही है। सुख की तलाश जितनी तेज हुई है, उतनी ही बेचैनी भी बढ़ी है। यह स्थिति हमें उसी पड़ाव की ओर ले जाती है कि वास्तविक सुख बाहर नहीं, बल्कि हमारे अपने भीतर है। उसे पाने का मार्ग आत्मचिंतन, संयम और संतुलित जीवन से होकर गुजरता है। यही जीवन की सच्ची ऊर्जा है।
